

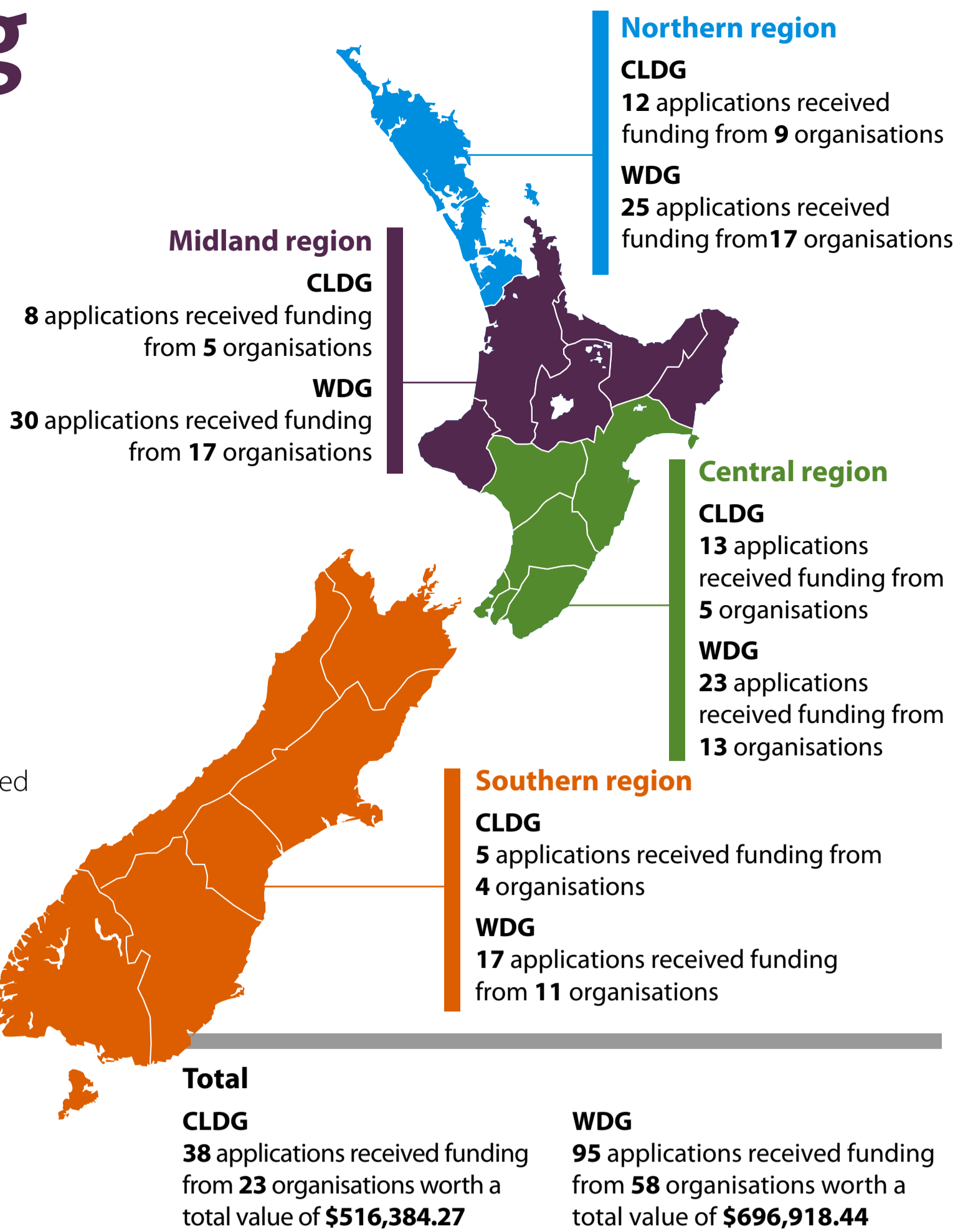
Supporting a stronger workforce

2016 summary of funded disability grants

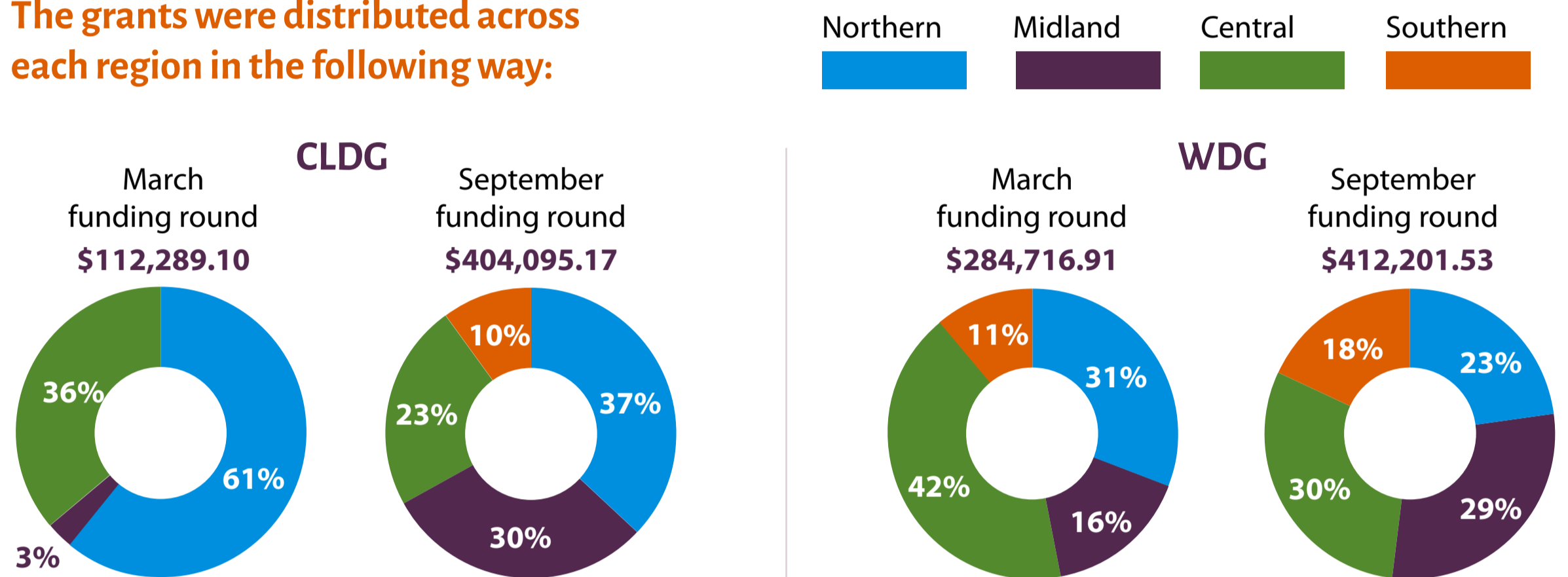
In 2016, 133 applications from 63 organisations across New Zealand received a consumer leadership development grant (CLDG) or workforce development grant (WDG) from Te Pou.

Two rounds of funding were held for each grant: one in March and one in September. For both grants, the September round funded at least 25 more applications than in March – for the CLDG, this was a 433% increase.

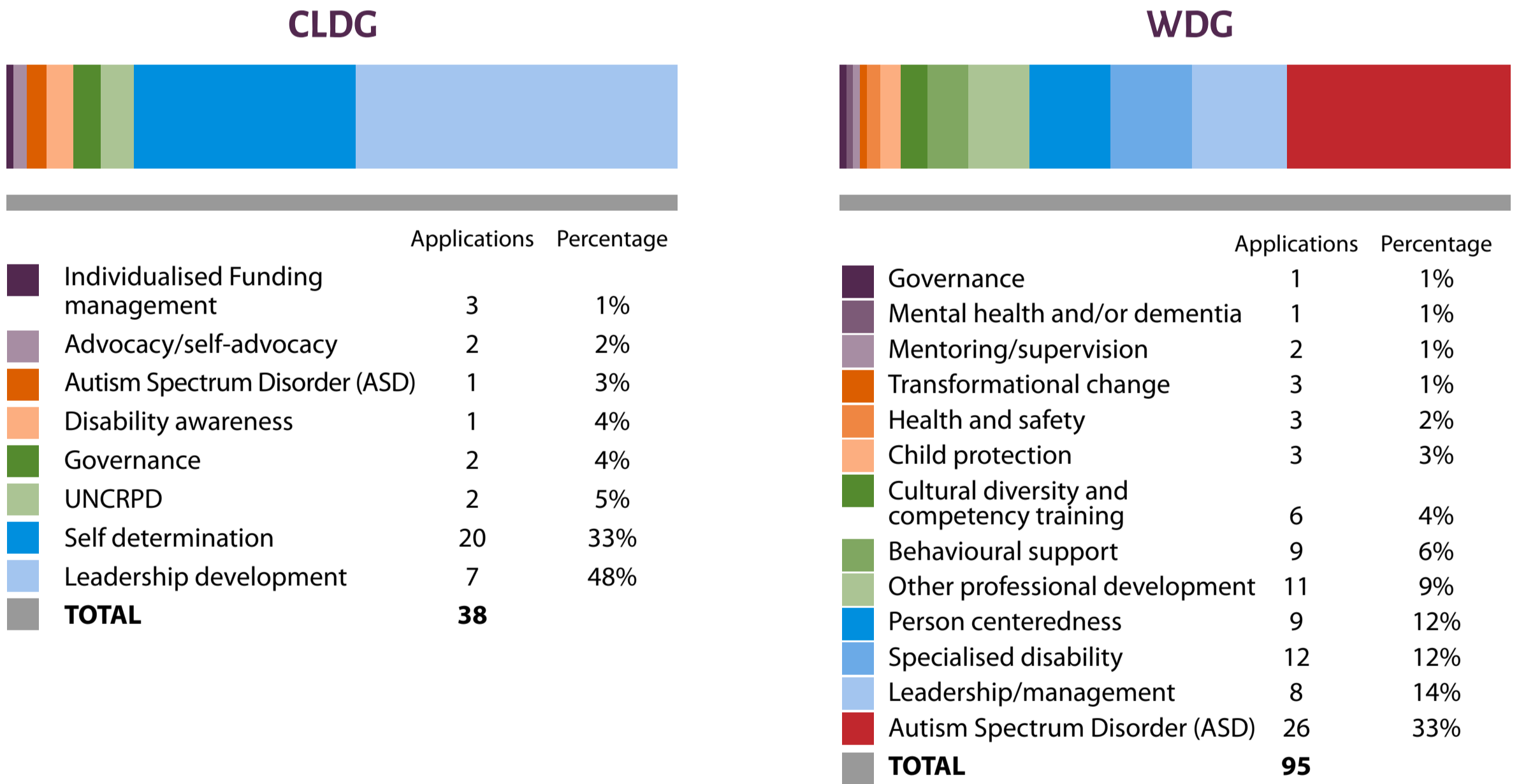
Here's how the grants were allocated across New Zealand.



The grants were distributed across each region in the following way:

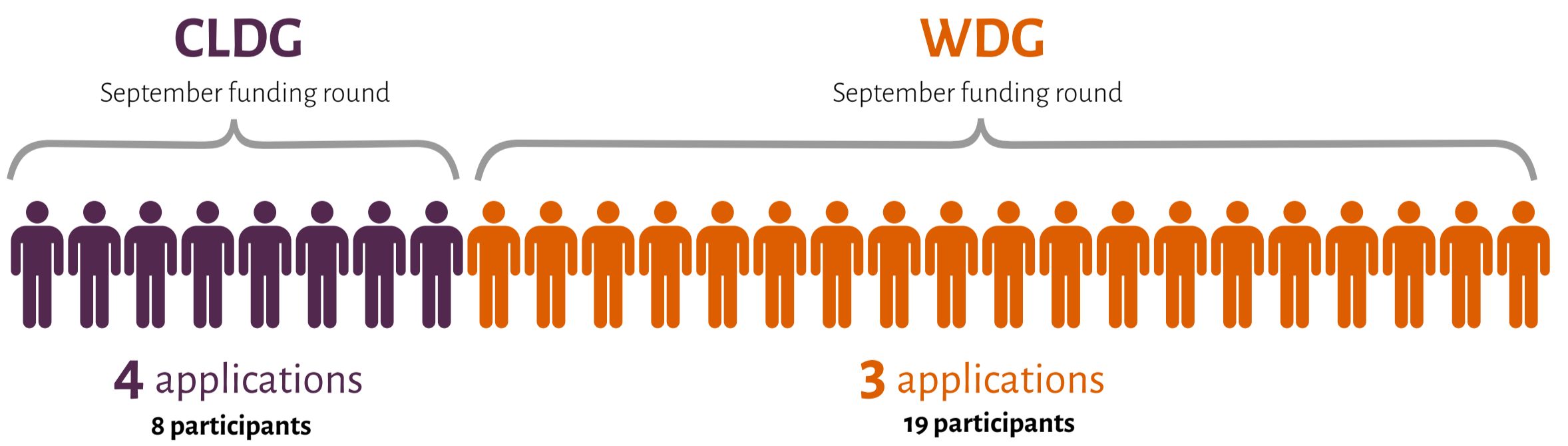


Learning activities funded and the percentage of funding allocated
