are partners, not passengers

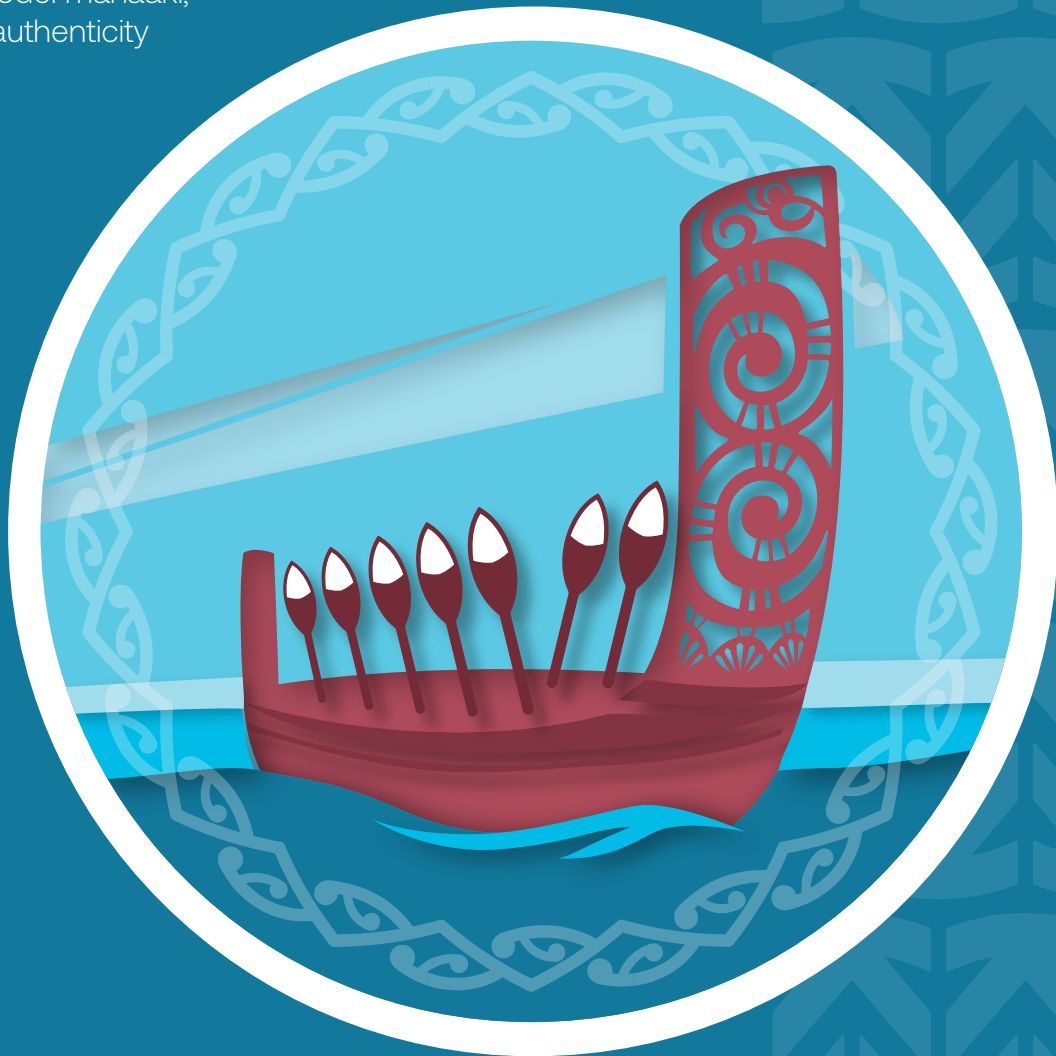


Ehara taku toa i te toa takitahi,

cultural safety builds trust

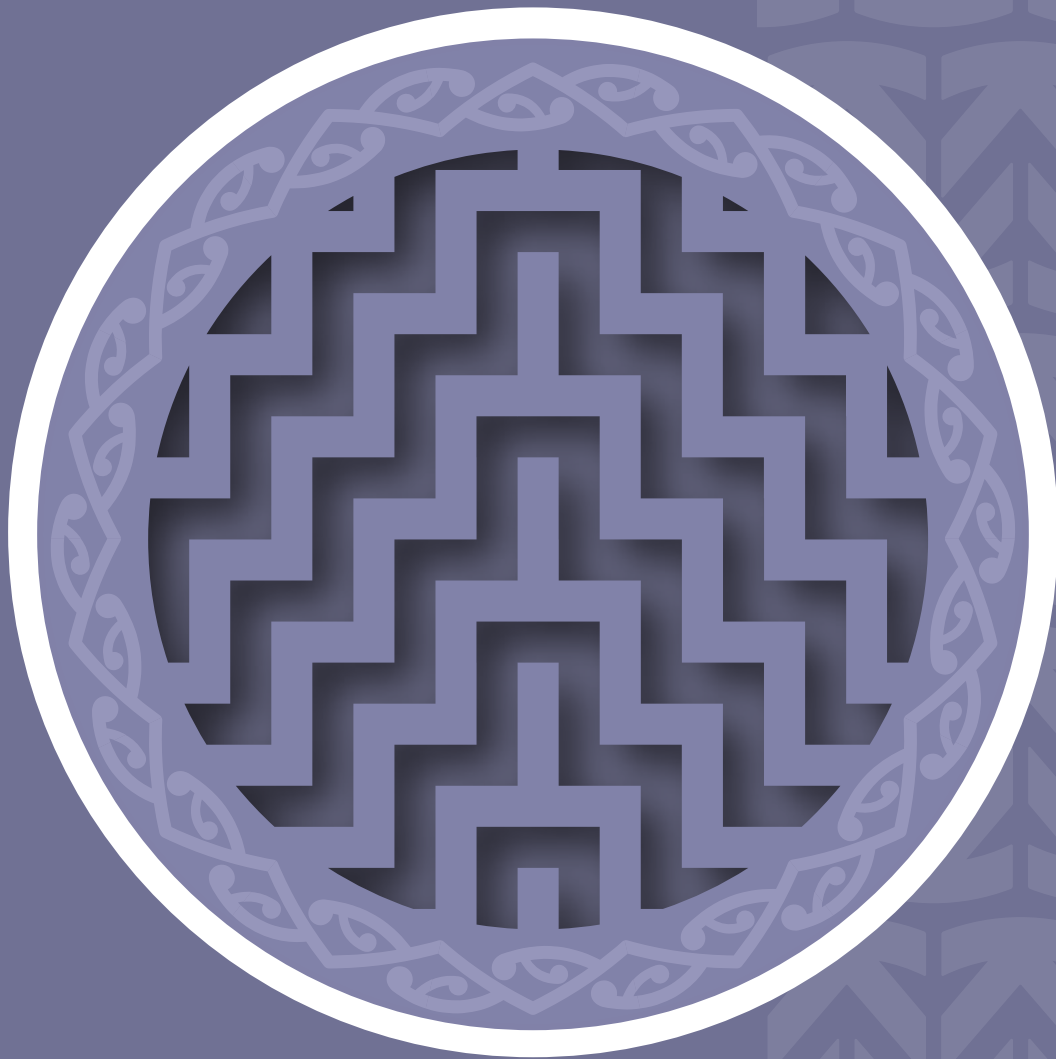


Nāu tō rourou, nāku rourou ka ora ai te iwi
